Tulip Festival Returns to its Roots in British Columbia's Fraser Valley

In 2024, the Fraser Valley will see its longest running tulip festival (formerly the Chilliwack Tulip Festival) return to its roots with a move to a new location in Agassiz, BC in the Harrison River Valley. Held annually in April/May, the new [Harrison Tulip Festival](#) will run for approximately four weeks, typically the third week of April through Mother's Day. Then, summer and autumn celebrations will follow with the [Harrison Sunflower Festival](#) in Aug/Sept and [Harrison Pumpkin Festival](#) in Sept/Oct. After operating their flower festivals in Chilliwack since 2017, the Onos family is thrilled to have acquired their own piece of land to host the new Harrison festivals and explore other agritourism opportunities.
